CORE OBJECTIVES FOR CONSTITUTION OF ANTI-RAGGING CELL

Dear all,

In consonance with Bar Council of India (BCI), Impact College of Law is being directed to establish Anti- Ragging Cell with the specific objectives herein as follows:

1. To prevent and prohibit ragging: This includes any act that constitutes physical or mental harassment, teasing, or mistreatment of fresher or any other student. The aim is to create and maintain a ragging-free environment within the institution and its premises.
2. To create awareness: Sensitizing students to the dehumanizing effects of ragging and informing them about the institution's policies, regulations, and the legal consequences of indulging in ragging.
3. To maintain vigilance: To continuously monitor and oversee areas prone to ragging, such as hostels, canteens, and other places of student congregation, to prevent the occurrence and recurrence of ragging incidents.
4. To take prompt action: To promptly and stringently deal with any reported incidents of ragging by conducting inquiries and taking appropriate disciplinary measures against those found guilty, as per the institution's rules and the law.
5. To promote a disciplined environment: To send a clear message that ragging will not be tolerated and that any act of ragging will not go unnoticed or unpunished, thereby fostering a culture of discipline and respect.
6. To build self-esteem and dignity: To create a supportive and congenial environment for all students, especially freshers, and to ensure their physical and psychological well-being.
7. To provide a mechanism for complaints: To establish clear channels and procedures for students to report incidents of ragging without fear of reprisal.
8. To conduct awareness programs: To organize orientation programs, workshops, and seminars to educate students about the evils of ragging and the measures in place to prevent it.
